On Sunday, March 29, 2009, at approximately 12:42 a.m., officers were dispatched to the 1500 block of Oak Hill Avenue in reference to the sound of gunshots. Officers found a residence and a vehicle had been struck by several gunshots. The residents were home at the time of the incident, no one was injured. The investigation is ongoing. On Sunday, March 29, 2009, at approximately 1:05 a.m., officers were dispatched to 11<sup>th</sup> and Vermont in reference to an Aggravated Robbery. Three Lawrence residents reported a lone suspect brandished a knife and demanded their wallets. The suspect punched one of the victims after obtaining only one wallet. The suspect was described as a white male, late 20's, approximately 5'09", goatee wearing a brown hoodie. The suspect was last seen running northwest. The investigation is ongoing. On Sunday, March 29, 2009, at approximately 2:05 a.m., an Officer on routine patrol heard a gunshot in the parking lot of Club Axis, 821 Iowa.
