On Monday January 5, 2010, at about 0820 hours Officers were dispatched to 1410 Kasold, Orchard's Drug in reference to a subject who ran behind the counter and stole several packages of controlled substances. The subject ran from the business and attempted to enter a residence nearby. When he was unable to make entry, he waived down a passing vehicle. The subject then took control of the vehicle and dragged the victim for a short distance as he sped away. The subject later was involved in an accident and then abandoned the on the KU campus.

The subsequent investigation revealed the suspect in this incident is **Trampas W. Hutchinson** W/M, DOB 02-08-79, 6'00"/165, Bro/Bro, transient, Lawrence, Kansas. Hutchinson is known to stay overnight in apartment building laundry rooms. He may be accompanied by a white female.

A warrant for Hutchinson's arrest has been issued for Robbery, Possession of Fentanyl, and Felony Theft.
