Attempted Aggravated Robbery

On Friday May 14, 2010, at 1:32 A.M., Lawrence Police Officers were dispatched to the 2600 block of W. 6th in reference to a burglary in progress. Upon arrival officers learned that two male suspects armed with a handgun had entered the apartment. The suspects made several of the people in the apartment get on the floor while at gunpoint. After a few moments the suspects fled the apartment. No one in the apartment was injured during the incident. A vehicle description was obtained by one of the victims. At 2:31 A.M. the suspect vehicle was located and stopped by the University of Kansas Police Department. Vernon D. Brooks II, a 23 year old Lawrence resident was taken into custody without incident. At 9:00 A.M. this morning officers located the second suspect, Jamal R. Greene, a 22 year old Lawrence resident in the 2300 block of Murphy Drive. Mr. Greene was taken into custody without incident. During the investigation the handgun used in the incident was recovered. The investigation is ongoing and no further information is available at this time.
